SPONSOR: Oak Ridge Sportsmen's Association Rifle and Pistol Club "Wind Dogs."

LOCATION: Oak Ridge, Tennessee – ORSA High Power Competition Range

RULES: NRA High Power Rifle Rules

ELIGIBILITY: Open

Classification: NRA classifications will be used. NRA members must provide their membership number for classification purposes. Unclassified competitors will fire in a separate class if 5 or more compete, otherwise unclassified competitors will be combined with the Master class.

FEES: \$25

REGISTRATION AND SQUADDING: 8:00 A.M. 600 yd. line. All competitors must complete registration before 8:30 to receive a relay and target assignment. Entries accepted to range capacity prior to the first relay. Match director reserves the right to modify match program at any time until firing begins.

RIFLE: NRA Rules

Sights: Metallic or optical sights as specified in NRA rule 3 allowable

AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition may be used in accordance with NRA Competition Rule 3.1.

SCORING: Match will be shot in three (3) relays

CHALLENGES: \$2 Fee

COURSE OF FIRE: Firing will commence at 9:00est A.M.

Match 1 – 600 yards, slow fire, prone, unlimited sighters and 20 shots fired in a 22-minute time limit

Match 2 – 600 yards, slow fire, prone, unlimited sighters and 20 shots fired in a 22-minute time limit

Match 3 – 600 yards, slow fire, prone, unlimited sighters and 20 shots fired in a 22-minute time limit

AWARDS: Cash Awards to match winners in Match 1-3. Additional place awards in classes and categories for every 5 competitors registered. Categories with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined within class. Class with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined with the next highest class.

DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE: The ORSA range is located on the Oak Ridge Turnpike (State Route 95) 3.5 miles west of the intersection with Illinois Ave. (State Route 62) and the Turnpike. The range entrance is the first road on the left after stop light #16 at Nebraska Ave.
