## ORSA PRECISION (BULLSEYE) PISTOL PRACTICE/LEAGUE

Ongoing, Every Tuesday Afternoon - 2023

Sponsored by: Oak Ridge Sportsmen's Association (orsaonline.org). Location: 2625 Oak Ridge Turnpike, Oak Ridge TN 37830.

Directions: The indoor/outdoor handgun ranges are located on State Route 95, 3.5 miles west of the intersection of Illinois Ave. (State Route 62), and the Turnpike. The ORSA entrance is the first road on the left (south) past stop light #16 at Nebraska Ave. Once inside the gate, go immediately, right. Ranges will be about 150 yards down the road. GPS: 35°59'12.8"N 84°19'28.6"W.

Entry Fee: Entry fee 'practice' is \$1.00 per 30 round 'National Match Course' [NMC] string of fire. This will include 3 targets and one scoring ticket. Junior entry fee is one-half off. Shooting is limited to 12 competitors at a time on a first come first served basis. As one participant finishes, another may then step up to the line at any time.

## Shooting starts at 1600

Rules: For league purposes, all current NRA/CMP Pistol Rules apply (Conventional/Precision), one (off-hand) handed shooting only.

Qualification: All new shooters will receive an initial assessment using a .22LR. Marksmanship, safety will be critiqued and if needed, basic instruction given. If the participant is unfamiliar with Bullseye 'One-Handed' shooting, they will use two hands, all shots must be 'on paper'.

Targets: B2 50Ft Slow Fire; B3 50Ft Timed/Rapid Fire (Indoor).

Scoring: Competitors will hang their own targets, score, replace. Challenges: All strings of fire will be scored after 10. Use of overlays, permitted. Use of plug type scoring gages will be restricted to range personnel and members of the Jury. A challenge fee of \$2 will be charged for each challenge made, returnable if upheld. See NRA rule 16 for correct procedure.

Classifications: NRA classifications will be used, Pistol rule 19 inclusive. Unclassified shooters will be placed in the Master Class except those who have an assigned classification under rule 19.14.

Eligibility: Open to any individual, NRA membership not required Categories: All shooters will compete in the Open Category.

Safety: All firearms will be pointed down range at all times. At the end of each NMC string of fire ECI's will be inserted, flashing 'cold-range' lights activated and only then will participants go forward for brass and trash. Handling of firearms in the forward room is not allowed.

Reporting: For League purposes, at the end of the winter indoor shooting season, if competitors desire, the aggregate average can be reported to the NRA for the standard upload fee.

## General Information:

Upon entering sign in and the RSO will check your kit.

Get your ticket, targets, pay your dollar.

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the range.

No re-shoots will be offered or alibis allowed.

RSO will assess new shooters during the 10 min' sight-in period.

At 4pm a sight-in warm-up period of 10 min' will be offered. Course of Fire: 30 round NMC, 300 point total

- \* Set 1 Slow Fire One, 10 round string in 10 minutes
- \* Set 2 Time Fire Two, 5 round strings in 20 seconds
- \* Set 3 Rapid Fire Two, 5 round strings in 10 seconds
- \* 5 minute break

Allowed Firearms Ammunition: Any safe pistol with a barrel length of -8" and under; Standard velocity in calibers only - Rimfire .22 LR/Short - Centerfire .32 S&W/ACP .38 ACP/Special/Kurtz 9mm Luger .40 S&W .41/44 Spec .45 ACP/GAP. No magnum high velocity [including Cor-Bon, +P, 'Stinger'] cartridges are to be used for this event.
